

How does a HAWK Signal Work?

What is a HAWK Signal?



A HAWK (High-Intensity Activated crossWalK) signal is a signal-beacon designed to help pedestrians safely cross busy streets. In 2022 Charlotte County installed a HAWK Signal on Olean Boulevard near Fawcett Hospital.

While different in appearance for motorists, for the pedestrian, this signal works like other push-button activated traffic signals by stopping traffic with a red signal, allowing pedestrians to cross with a WALK signal.

HAWK signals can be installed on streets with regular traffic signals as part of the County's coordinated signal system.
