Dear Property Owner:

As you may be aware, portions of the East and West Spring Lake Wastewater Expansion Project have begun to bring centralized wastewater service to your neighborhood. We are writing to provide an update on the status of the project and to invite you to a presentation with an opportunity to speak with Charlotte County Utilities (CCU) and the contractors who will be hard at work completing this project. CCU is hosting two public information sessions on Tuesday, June 30 for residents who are living and/or own property in the area known as "Contract C" for the East and West Spring Lake Wastewater Expansion Program, as outlined in the map at the end of this letter.

Topics of interest at the presentation will include: what to expect during construction, a tentative timeline, access considerations, location of connections, restoration, and a presentation by the University of Florida Extension Services on Florida Friendly Landscaping. Additional sessions for residents living in other areas of this project will be held at future dates.

There will be two sessions held that will have the same information presented at both. We invite you to attend the meeting time that is the most convenient for you. We will have representatives from CCU and our contractors in attendance. After a brief project overview from CCU and a presentation from the University of Florida Extension Services, you will have the opportunity to visit the tables and booths that most interest you and ask specific questions or make comments. We hope you will come and learn more. Details on location and time are as follows:

Project Status: Stevens and Layton, Inc. from Ft. Myers has been awarded the construction contract for the vacuum sewer collection system in your area. They are scheduled to begin construction during the week of June 15th. The initial stages of construction will include establishing staging and storage sites throughout the project limits, which will include several County and privately owned lots as well as portions of Lincoln Park. In addition, Stevens and Layton intends to start work within the right-of-way along the northern portions of West Tarpon Boulevard between Lakemont Avenue and North Spring Lake Boulevard.

Construction of the vacuum collection station is also progressing on schedule at the intersection of Azalea Avenue and Skylark Lane with an anticipated completion date of April 2016. Connection of your home to the central sewer system is expected to begin in the spring of 2016.

As construction progresses, residents will be notified of work in their immediate area via door hangers to be delivered by the contractor. Residents may also find progress updates on our website www.charlottecountyfl.com/CCU or Facebook page.

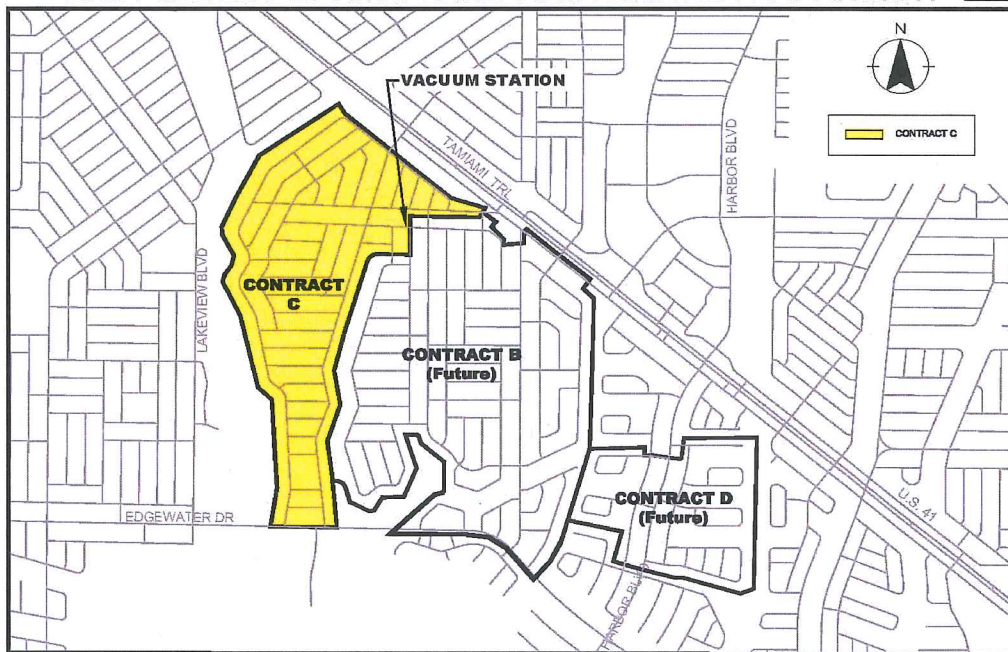
